

Accredited Supervisor Course



This course is recognised as a Certificate of Attainment in Professional Supervision by the ACA, and endorsed by ACWA, AASW and PACFA. The course provides the fundamental knowledge required in establishing a competency-based supervision working alliance including the fundamentals of setting up supervision using clear learning goals, establishing a learning contract, how to use reflective questioning techniques in supervision and how to provide effective feedback to develop best practice skills in supervision.

The course is divided into three parts:

Part 1: Supervision E-Workbook - self study (35 hours CPD)

Prior to attending the 2 day workshop participants are provided with a free Supervision E-Workbook covering core preparatory readings, learning resources, links to clinical supervision training videos and podcast lectures. As a participant of the Accredited Clinical Supervisor course you will be expected to work through and complete all learning and the self-assessment tasks. This workbook is an invaluable guide that covers how to set up, conduct and evaluate effective supervision.

Part 2: Workshop - 2 days x 7 hours (14 hours CPD)

By undertaking this course participants will enhance their knowledge, skills and confidence to set up a competency-based supervision working alliance. Participants will also develop their skills in establishing a clear contract and learning goals and develop skills in reflective questioning in individual, peer and group contexts. There will be opportunities to practice using various supervision assessment and feedback tools as well as using evaluation within the supervision session.

Part 3: Assessment of Supervisor Competency Skills - 1 day x 7 hours (7 hours CPD)

This is the formal assessment day. Final assessments will include live, in real time 60 minute formally assessed supervision sessions.
