

# On being the Supervisee



E-learning Course - for allied health, nursing and counsellors

This course provides information on how to get the most out of supervision. **Module 2 will give you a host of different ways to practice working reflectively in practice and thinking about your clinical work.**

**There are a number of tools that are provided and you are invited to think about and try these tools with your supervisor.**

Topics included in Module 2 include:

- Working alliance (Role induction)
- Case presentation guidelines
- Case formulation guidelines
- Reflective practice
- How to receive and give feedback
- Methods and techniques in supervision to enhance your learning.

- Have a sound knowledge of the role of clinical supervision
- Recognise the importance of receiving supervision and the benefits to clients
- Be aware of the different models of supervision
- Be introduced to the role of the initial supervisor-supervisee meeting (Role Induction/Working Alliance)

- Be introduced to various techniques of best practice supervision as well as reflective practice
- Understand the value of effective feedback and evaluation so that it facilitates your learning
